Compelling evidence from serious scientific studies, including three controlled trials in Uganda, Kenya and South Africa, have demonstrated in 2007 the effectiveness of adult male circumcision in dramatically reducing HIV transmission heterosexually to uninfected men.

Surgery (male circumcision) is now becoming an important additional tool in the global fight against HIV and AIDS.
